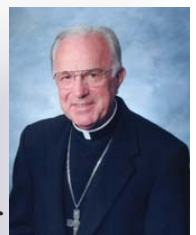

Yesterday, March 13, 2010 at noon was a big day for all St. Gabriel's parishioners! It was the beginning of St. Gabriel's new church becoming a reality.



The rite consisted of the blessing of the site of the new church, the blessing and laying of the foundation stone, and the burial of our time capsule. Excited parishioners gathered at the patio of the existing church building at 11:45am. The ceremony began with the prayer of the Angelus and the greeting by Bishop Brom at noon. A beautiful and moving procession to the building site followed.

We joyously prayed together as Bishop Brom blessed our foundation stone and knelt at the site of our new altar. We listened reverently to the Liturgy of the Word and sang songs of worship and praise.

We also buried St. Gabriel's time capsule beneath the cornerstone of the foundation.

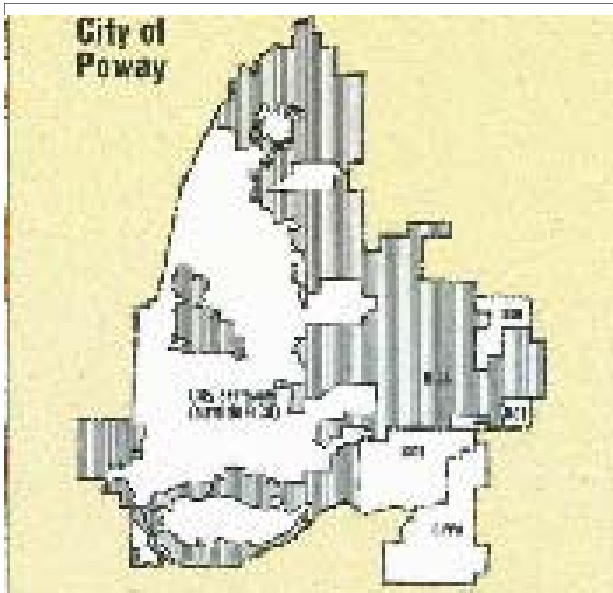

MITIGATION LAND

This is a map of the Conservation Plan that can be found on the Poway City website and from which the St. Gabriel's parish has to purchase eight (8) acres of land in replacement of the disturbed area created by the construction of the new church and the new parking lot. If you are the fortunate owner of land designated on this map as CSS (coastal sage scrub) shown in the red color and contained within the mitigation area boundary outlined in black around the Twin Peaks region, hope is on the horizon in the form of a tax deduction option. Instead of the church paying \$17,000 an acre to the city (in lieu of actual land) St. Gabriel's can provide you with a tax deduction in the same amount. Please contact Fr. Michael or Gary Ghio at the parish office if you have any land that may qualify for this

opportunity.

St. Gabriel's is required to pay a \$700 mapping fee and a biologist's fee for each separate lot of land submitted for the offsite mitigation requirement. Therefore, the larger the acreage of your donation, the greater the benefit to St. Gabriel's.
